

Beginning Danish Research

Different research sources:

- Parish records include birth, introduction (where the mother was allowed back into the church after her “sin” of giving birth), confirmation (usually done when children were between 14 and 17 years of age), engagement, marriage, death and Moving in (Tilgangslister) and Moving out (Afgangslister) records.

- Military lists started about 1788. These listed all healthy males from birth through 38 or 44. After 1849 the lists only included males over 15. The lists almost always included the name of the father and their residence and relocations.
